



## The Southpointe CEO Association Jack B. Piatt Scholarship Program

Celebrating and encouraging leadership development in business, community, and school, the Southpointe CEO Association (SPCEO) will award \$10,000 in scholarships to individuals who have demonstrated excellence in leadership. The program is open to individuals who are employees, or dependents of employees, of Association member organizations and reside in Washington County. The scholarships are awarded in honor and memory of Jack B. Piatt, Founder and Chairman of Millcraft Investments and Founder of the Southpointe CEO Association.

This program aims to provide support to those who seek to make a positive impact in the Washington County community through the completion of a college, post-graduate, or technical degree. By recognizing persons who strive to improve their leadership skills and achieve higher levels of education, these scholarships will help to make those dreams a reality.

### Eligibility Criteria:

- The SPCEO Jack B. Piatt Scholarship Program is open to anyone attending a college, post-secondary, or technical school in the 2021-22 academic year.
- Applicants must be a current employee (or dependent of an employee) of a member organization of the Southpointe CEO Association. All members of the Washington Chamber of Commerce who have a business located in Southpointe or conduct business in Southpointe are also considered members of the Southpointe CEO Association and are eligible to apply.
- Applicants must reside in Washington County.

### Application Criteria:

- Submit an essay (1,000 words or less) on the topic below:  
Explain what you plan to study and the importance of your chosen major in today's workforce. How do you plan to be a leader in your field?
- Submit a cover letter for your essay and include the following:  
Contact information  
How you are connected to a member organization  
What institution you attend/plan to attend
- Submit two professional letters of reference.
- Prospective students: Submit a copy of your high school academic transcript and a copy of acceptance letter/proof of enrollment for the institution you plan to attend in 2021-22.
- Current College/Graduate/Technical Students: Submit a copy of your academic transcript or most recent report card and proof of enrollment for 2021-22 academic year.

**Deadline:** Friday, May 28, 2021 by 4:00 p.m. (EST) (no exceptions). Applications postmarked after May 28, 2021 or emails after this date/time will not be considered. Awards will be announced June 2021.
